- Bachelor's Degree with a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.50 (on a four-point scale) or equivalent. If your degree is not under the field of Education, students will need to enroll in two Foundation courses.
- Applicants who do not meet the requirements may be admitted to the Program but must maintain a GPA of 3.0 upon completion of 12 credits.
- Applicants must achieve the minimum score on any one of the following English proficiency tests:
 - TOEIC: 550 (or above)
 - TOEFL: 500 (or above)
 - IELTS: 5.5 band score
- Applicants must submit the following:
 - Completed Application Form
 - Official copy of Transcripts
 - Photocopy of Passport Bio page
 - Two 2x2 inch photos
 - Application Fee of 3,000 Thai Baht
